Lesson 3: Jesus Meets a Samaritan Woman

Bible reading: John 4: 1-42

Memory verse: John 3:16

“For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.”

Explanation:

God is the Creator of everything, even people. When the Bible says God loved the world, it means the people of the world. You are one of those people. God loves you! Jesus Christ is God’s one and only Son. God sent Jesus to Earth to die on the cross to take the punishment for your sin. Sin is anything you and I think, say or do that break God’s laws. We deserve to perish or be punished for our sin, being kept away from God forever. You need to believe in Jesus by trusting what

He did for you on the cross. If you truly trust Him, you will be forgiven. When you believe in Jesus, God gives you everlasting life. That means your sins are forgiven and someday you can be with God in Heaven.

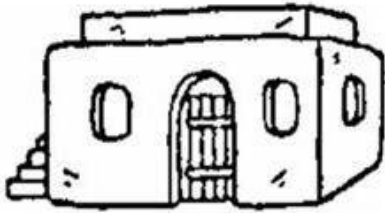
(A) Please answer the following questions in relation to your Bible Reading above.
