### **John 4:5-8**

- After teaching in Judea, Jesus decided to return to Galilee. He needed to go through Samaria.
- Jesus' followers were with Him.
- They were hungry and tired
- Jesus sat by a well to rest
- The disciples went to buy food

### **John 4:7-15**

- A Samaritan woman came for water
- Jesus surprised her by asking for a drink
- The woman didn't understand

### **John 4:16-25**

- Jesus asked her to bring her husband
- The woman tried to change the subject

### **John 4:26**

- The woman was amazed- Jesus was the promised Saviour from sin.
- The Samaritan woman received the living water, she believed that Jesus is the Messiah, the wonderful Saviour.
- The disciples return to the well
- The woman ran to the city to tell about Jesus

### **John 4: 30-42**

- People from the city came to see Christ and many believed.

### **Message:**

- Jesus cares for the Samaritan woman and so He cares for you too
- You and I are sinners too
- Jesus came to save you from your sin
- Share the good news of Jesus with others.
- You can believe in Jesus and have everlasting life.

**Matthew 6:5-15**

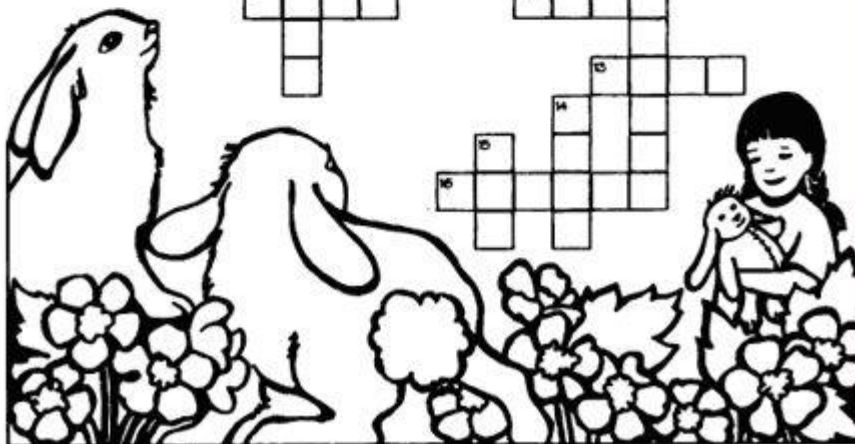
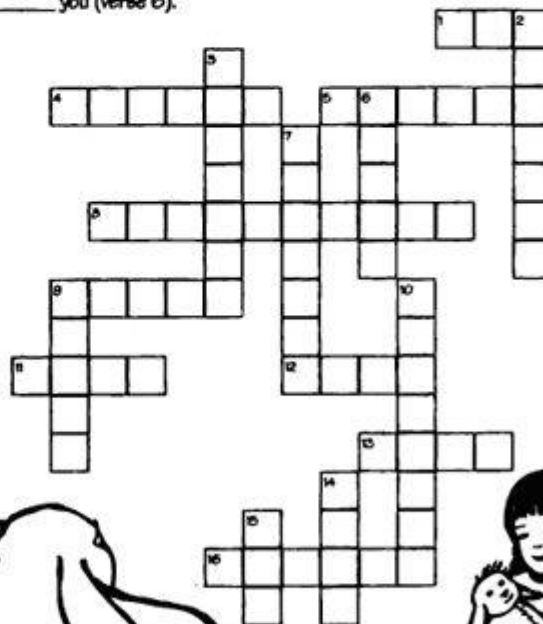
