Lesson 2

Topic: Jesus cares for His disciples.

Bible Reading: Mark 4:35-39

Memory Verse: Romans 1:16

“For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to everyone that believeth.”

EXPLANATION:

Paul was not ashamed about believing in the Gospel of Jesus Christ, the Good News that Jesus died and came alive again so people can be forgiven for their sins. What Jesus did on the cross is the only way God made for you to be saved from the punishment of sins. Sin is something that you think, say or do that make God sad. If you believe on Jesus, by telling Him that you are sorry and trusting Him to forgive you, you can have salvation (saved from sins). Jesus, God’s Son is the only one with that power.

1. Why was Jesus so tired?
2. What happened that made the disciples afraid?
3. What are some things that makes boys and girls like you afraid?
4. If you have Jesus as your Saviour, what do you need to remember when you are afraid?

6. Why is sin such a terrible problem?
7. When the disciple woke Jesus up, what did they ask Him?
8. What does Romans 5:8 says God did to show He loves us?
9. What did Jesus do to stop the stormy wind and sea?
10. Why was Jesus able to stop the storm?
11. What did Jesus do to take care of the problem you have with sin?
12. Why might Jesus have been sad that the disciples were afraid?

You could take time to listen to your friend and pray for him/her or read him/her a Bible verse. If your friend has not believed in Jesus, you could tell him/her how to trust in the Lord Jesus to be forgiven of their sin. If Jesus has saved you from your sin and is your friend, He wants you to be friends to others. (Please look up John 15:12). As you show God's love to others, God can use you to meet the needs in their lives. Even praying for others from your own home is meeting a need of a friend.
