Lesson 3: Jesus Meets a Samaritan Women

Hello Kids and parents, welcome to revision week for lesson 3. Let's find out how much the kids remember their last lesson. Ready.....

1. Memory Verse

Have the kids recall their memory verse for last week to see how much they remember. If they are able to remember the memory verse by heart, VERY GOOD!!!, have a little reward for them e.g. a little snack/candy or toy for them.

Say the memory verse together with your kids twice or more before going to the lesson, this is to ensure that kids have learnt the memory verse.

2. Bible Story is taken from the book of John 4:1-42

Parents can ask their kids to tell them the bible story this time. Or discuss the bible story together to see how much they remember. [For bible story as well, if the kids remember the bible story well, reward them if possible, this acts as a motivational tool to help kids learn more while enjoying].

3. Preschool Review Questions

After discussing the bible story with your kids, parents can ask these same simple questions again this week to see if the children have understood the lesson fully or not.

1. Why did Jesus and His Disciples stop at the well? [They were tired and hungry]
2. What did Jesus ask the women at the well to do for Him? [Give Him a drink]
3. Who loved the women even though she did things that were wrong? [Jesus]
4. What do we call the things we do that make God sad? [Sin]
5. Who loves you the most? [God]
6. Who is Jesus? [Son of God]
7. What did Jesus do for you? [Died on the cross for your sins]
8. Is Jesus still dead? [NO!! His alive]
9. How can Jesus be your savior? [You can tell God three things: I know I have sinned and I'm sorry; I believe Jesus died for my sins and came alive again; please forgive my sin and make me Your child.]
10. Who can you tell about Jesus? [Friends/ Family Member/Unbelievers/Classmates etc.]

4. Activity

I hope you enjoyed last week's activities as well.

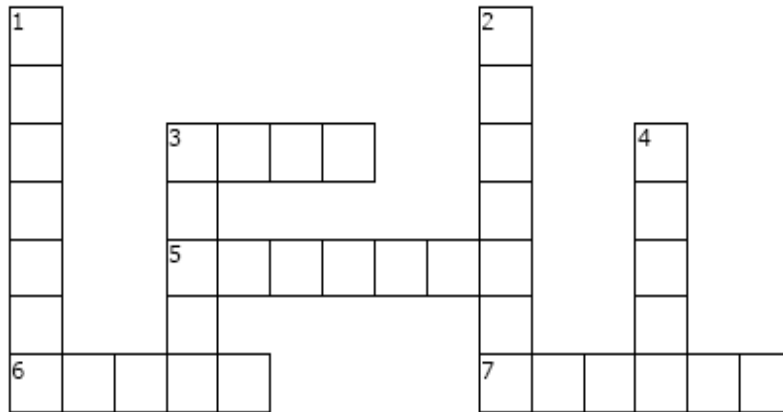
