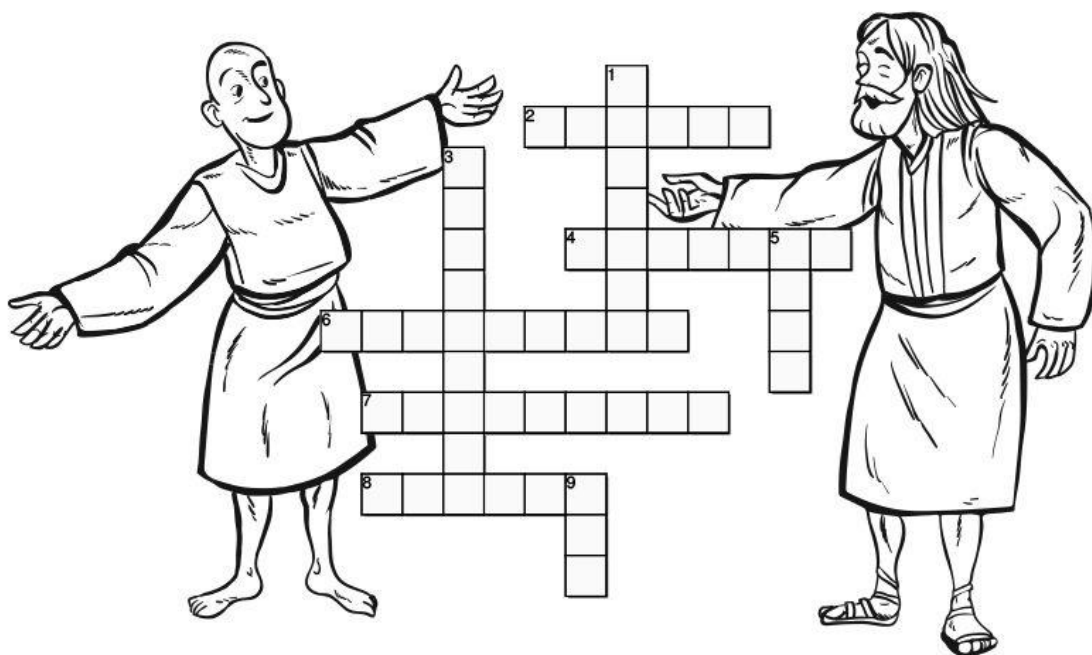


JESUS HEALS A PARALYZED MAN

INVITATION

What about you? Have your sins be forgiven? Jesus died on the cross so you don't have to be punished for your sins. The Bible say, "whosoever believeth in Him shall have eternal life". (John 3:15). If you believe (trust completely) in the Lord Jesus and He did on the cross for you as the only way your sin can be forgiven, you will not perish (have to be separated from God). He will change you on the inside and help you live to please Him. One day you will have to live with Him forever.
