Lesson 5: Jesus Answers a Lawyer's Question


God is good! All the Time! And all the time God is good! Maranatha Everyone!!!! Pray everyone is well and good.

Hello Kids and parents, welcome to revision week for lesson 5 our last lesson for Jesus: My Savior and Friend. Let's find out how much the kids remember their last lesson. Ready...... let's Start......

1. Memory Verse

Have the kids recall their memory verse for last week to see how much they remember. If they are able to remember the memory verse by heart, VERY GOOD!!!, have a little reward for them e.g. a little snack/candy or toy for them.

Say the memory verse together with your kids twice or more before going to the lesson, this is to ensure that kids have learnt the memory verse.



2.Bible Story is taken from the book of Luke 10:25-37

Parents can ask their kids to tell them the bible story this time. Or discuss the bible story together to see how much they remember. [For bible story as well, if the kids remember the bible story well, reward them if possible, this acts as a motivational tool to help kids learn more while enjoying].

3. Preschool Review Questions

After discussing the bible story with your kids, parents can ask these same simple questions again this week to see if the children have understood the lesson fully or not.

- 1. What does John 3:16 say? [Quote the memory verse]
- 2. John 3:16 says God loves who? [The world]
- 3. What are some of the ways you can show to your neighbors? [answers will vary]
- 4. What happened to the Jewish man in the story Jesus told? [He was attacked by robbers]
- 5. What did the priest and the Levite do when they saw the injured man? [They passed by]
- 6. Name two things that the Samaritan did to help the injured man? [Put bandages on his wounds, took him to an inn, took care of him]
- 7. Who does God want you to show love to? [Everyone]
- 8. How can you show love to others? [Answers will vary]
- 9. How did God show His love to us? [Sent Jesus to die on the cross]
- 10. Are we saved through our good deeds? [No]

4. Activity

I hope the kids enjoyed last week's activities as well.

Please refer to the attached images and feel free to print them out for your kids for their activity.




Jesus Teaches About Helping
