Lesson 4: Jesus Heals the Centurion's Servant

Welcome to Lesson 4 Kids and Parents. I hope you all enjoy the lessons that are sent every week and learn something new every week. Most importantly still remember what was taught.....So let's begin with our lesson 4,

1. Kids to Learn their memory Verse and memorize them by heart and say it throughout the week, e.g.: as they wake up or before going to bed and during the day.

It's a good practice and parents can help them memorize by learning with them. This week for memory verse, we have a very famous verse from the bible:

Memory Verse

Acts 4:12

"Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved".

2. Bible Story is taken from the book of Luke 7:1-10

Parents can read the story from the bible and explain it to their kids in the simple way that they understand. Briefly on the Story on: Jesus Heals the Centurion's Servant

Jesus went to Capernaum. A Centurion's valued servant was sick and near death. [You and I have an even more serious problem because of sin]. The Centurion knew about Jesus. The Centurion was a gentile. He sent Jewish elders to ask Jesus if He would come and heal his servant. The elders begged Jesus to go to the servant. [Do you know that Jesus is your only Hope for being saved from your sins?]

Jesus went with the elders. When they were close to the Centurion's house, Jesus was met by friends of the Centurion. The Centurion's friends told Jesus that the Centurion did not feel worthy to have Jesus come to his house. The Centurion reasoned that just as his commands were obeyed, so would Jesus' word of healing be obeyed, Jesus was amazed and proclaimed to the people the great faith of the gentile Centurion.

[God wants you to believe He can do anything]. Jesus said the Centurion's request had been granted. Jesus loved the gentile Centurion and his servant. [Jesus loves you too-no matter where you are from, what you look like or who you are. His Servant was Healed-Jesus, the Son of God, had saved the servant's life.

3. Review Questions

After reading the bible story, parents can ask these simple questions to see if the children have understood the lesson or not.

1. Tell one thing you know about God? [Answers will vary]
2. What did the Centurion want Jesus to do? [Heal his servant]
3. Who is Jesus? [Son of God]
4. What can Jesus do that no one else can do? [Do miracles]
5. What did Jesus do to take care of your sin? [Died on the cross]
6. What is sin? [Anything you think, say or do that makes God sad]
7. How many people have sinned? [Everyone or all]
8. What does John 3:16 say? [Quote memory verse for last lesson]
9. What amazed Jesus about the Centurion? [His Faith]
10. What are some difficult things God is able to take care of in our lives? [Heal us, finding job, help in studies with wisdom etc.]

4. Activity

I hope the kids enjoy the activities sent for every lesson.

It is believed that kids learn more while doing related activities to the lesson learnt. This week I have attached a couple of activities for the kids to do throughout the week to learn more about the lesson.

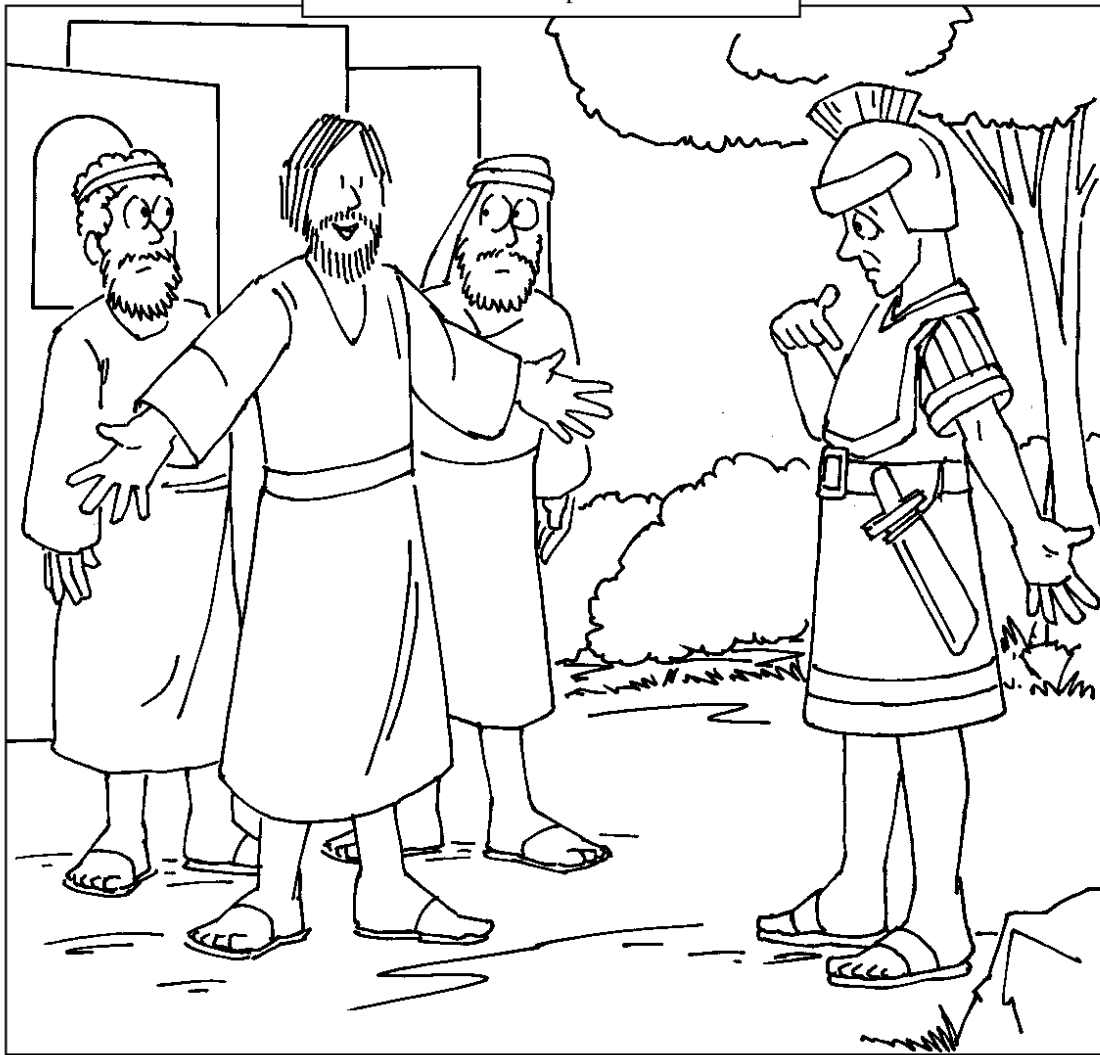
