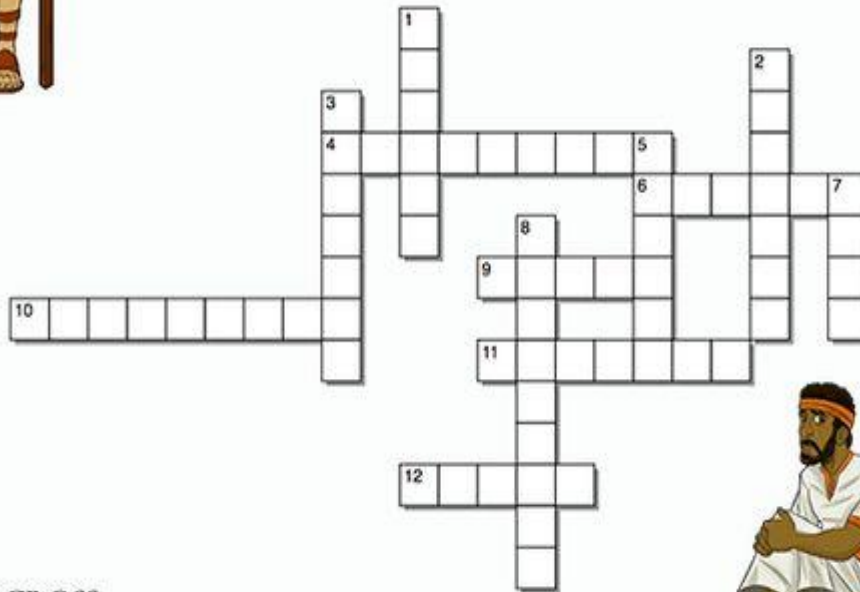

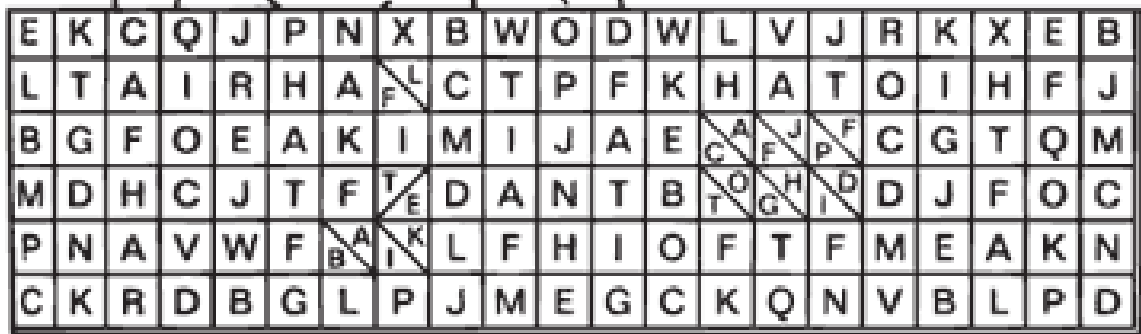
Centurion's Servant Healed

The centurion believed that Jesus could heal his sick servant with only a word! And Jesus saw that this man had great faith. Jesus hopes to see our faith in Him too.



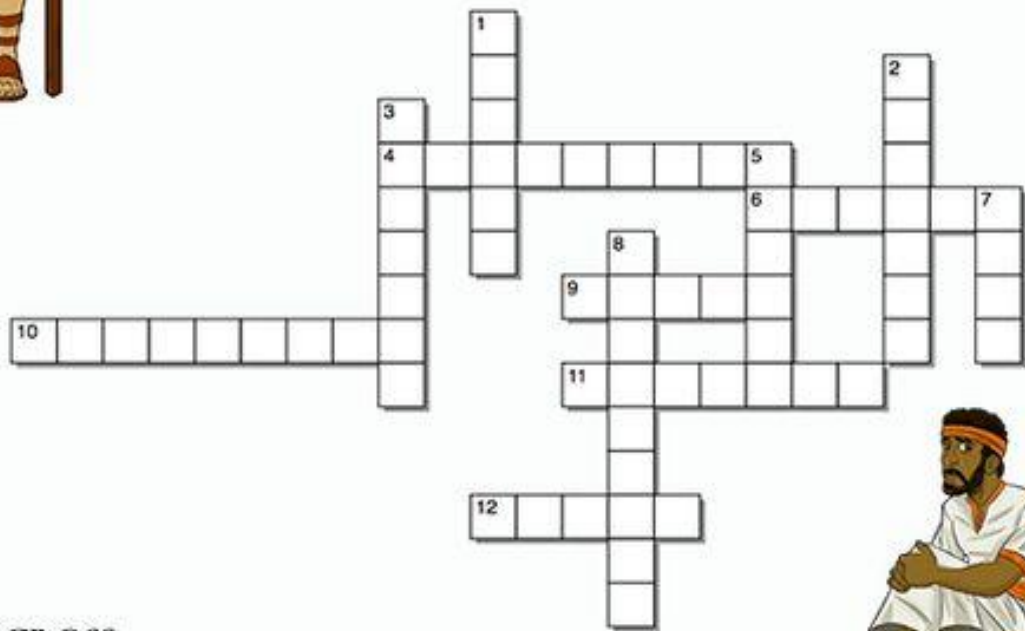
