FOLLOW ME: PETER LEARNS FROM CHRIST

Lesson 1: Introducing Peter

1. Kids to Learn their memory Verse and memorize them by heart and say it throughout the week, e.g.: as they wake up or before going to bed and during the day.

It's a good practice and parents can help them memorize by learning with them.

Memory Verse

Matthew 4:19

"Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men".

Matthew 4:19

2. Bible Story is taken from the book of John 1:19-23; Luke 5:1-16

Parents can read the story from the bible and explain it to their kids in the simple way that they understand.

Briefly on the Story on: Introducing Peter

Bethsaida was a little town on the shore of the Sea of Galilee. The Jews had been waiting on the Messiah. Simon, Andrew, James and John grew up in Bethsaida. One day they met an unusual man named John the Baptist.

God chose John the Baptist to tell the Jews to be ready for the Messiah. Andrew became a disciple [learner or follower] of John the Baptist. John saw Jesus and cried out, "Behold, the Lamb of God!" Andrew realized that Jesus is the Messiah! Andrew went to tell his brother Simon. [You and I need a Savior for the same reason-we are sinners.] Andrew brought Simon to Jesus. Jesus changed Simon's name to Cephas [Peter]. [Did you know that God has a great plan for your life?] Hundreds of people followed Jesus to hear Him teach. Jesu was teaching and the crowd kept getting closer and closer to hear Him teach.

Jesus got into Peter's boat and taught the people from the boat a little way off the shore. Jesus told Peter to let out his nets to catch fish. The net filled with fish and Peter called out to James and John to come help. Peter started to realize who Jesus is. Jesus came to Earth to take the punishment for Peter's sin and the sin of everyone in the whole world. Jesus told them not to be afraid and, "From now on, you will catch men".

[If you have believed on Jesus as your Savior, be a fisher of men and lead others to Jesus]. When Jesus said, "Follow Me!" they left their fishing business and became Jesus' followers. Peter, Andrew, James and John became four of the 12 disciples of Jesus. [The First step in following Jesus is to believe on Him as Savior.

3. Preschool Review Questions

After reading the bible story, parents can ask these simple questions to see if the children have understood the lesson or not.

- 1. When John the Baptist said, "Behold the Lamb of God!" who was he talking about? [Jesus]
- 2. In the beginning of the lesson, what was Simon, Andrew, James and John's job? [To catch fish]
- 3. What is Sin? [Anything we think, say or do that makes God Sad.]
- 4. Why do you and I need a Savior? [Because of our sins]
- 5. What does it mean to fish for men? [Tell people about Jesus]
- 6. Where is Jesus now? [In Heaven ruling as king]
- 7. What is disciple? [A learner or follower of someone.]
- 8. What did Jesus tell Peter to do when they were in the boat and a little farther into the water? [Throw his net into the water so he could catch fish.]
- 9. After Jesus told Peter to throw his net into the water, did he catch any fish? [Yes! He caught a lot of Fish]
- 10. Who knows everything about you? [God]




