Lesson 1: Introducing Peter

Maranatha Everyone. hat everyone is well and I hope you enjoyed last week's lesson.

For each lesson we take two Sundays to teach the children, the first week is teaching the lesson and the second week is basically revision week, to test the kids of how much they can recall from the first week's lesson.

1. Memory Verse

Have the kids recall their memory verse for last week to see how much they remember. If they are able to remember the memory verse by heart, VERY GOOD!!!, have a little reward for them e.g. a little snack/candy or toy for them.

Say the memory verse together with your kids twice or more before going to the lesson, this is to ensure that kids have learnt the memory verse.



2. Bible Story is taken from the book of John 1:19-23; Luke 5:1-16

Parents can ask their kids to tell them the bible story this time. Or discuss the bible story together to see how much they remember. [For bible story as well, if the kids remember the bible story well, reward them if possible, this acts as a motivational tool to help kids learn more while enjoying].

3. Preschool Review Questions

After discussing the bible story with your kids, parents can ask these same simple questions again this week to see if the children have understood the lesson fully or not.

- 1. When John the Baptist said, "Behold the Lamb of God!" who was he talking about? [Jesus]
- 2. In the beginning of the lesson, what was Simon, Andrew, James and John's job? [To catch fish]
- 3. What is Sin? [Anything we think, say or do that makes God Sad.]
- 4. Why do you and I need a Savior? [Because of our sins]

- 5. What does it mean to fish for men? [Tell people about Jesus]
- 6. Where is Jesus now? [In Heaven ruling as king]
- 7. What is disciple? [A learner or follower of someone.]
- 8. What did Jesus tell Peter to do when they were in the boat and a little farther into the water? [Throw his net into the water so he could catch fish.]
- 9. After Jesus told Peter to throw his net into the water, did he catch any fish? [Yes! He caught a lot of Fish]
- 10. Who knows everything about you? [God]

4. Activity

I hope the kids enjoyed the first lesson and the activities as well.

It is believed that kids learn more while doing related activities to the lesson learnt. This week I have attached a couple of activities for the kids to do throughout the week to learn more about the lesson.

Please refer to the attached images and feel free to print them out for your kids for their activity.




